Incident #: 2024-326 Traffic Crash (Injury)

On January 20, 2024, at approximately 8:45 am, Barrington Hills Police responded to Algonquin Road (Rt.62) east of Old Sutton Road for a vehicle crash with injuries. The preliminary investigation indicates that a Honda CRV travelling east on Algonquin Road crossed the centerline and collided with a Barrington Countryside Fire Protection District Ford Expedition, which was travelling west on Algonquin Road responding to another emergency. The emergency lights and siren on the fire department vehicle were activated at the time of the crash.

Ambulances from Carpentersville and East Dundee responded to the scene. The driver of the fire department vehicle, the only occupant, was transported to Good Shepherd Hospital for treatment of serious but non-life-threatening injuries. The occupants of the Honda CRV were transported to St. Alexius Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries and later released.

Barrington Hills Police were assisted by Hoffman Estates Police, Algonquin Police and Hanover Township Emergency Services for traffic control around the scene. Algonquin Road was closed between Old Sutton Road and Dundee Road (Rt.68) until approximately 2:00 pm.

The crash remains under investigation by Barrington Hills Police and the Major Crash Assistance Team.
